

Apply soon for febrile infant guideline QI effort

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Professionals in acute hospital care, pediatric hospital medicine and emergency medicine (pediatric and adult) are encouraged to view an informational webinar about a quality improvement (QI) effort to standardize care for febrile infants in hospital settings.

The AAP Value in Inpatient Pediatrics Network uses recommendations from the AAP clinical practice guideline *Evaluation and Management of Well-Appearing Febrile Infants 8-60 Days Old* to provide education to hospital and emergency medicine teams that participate in the QI project. Participants will receive ongoing support to implement the guideline at their site as they collaborate with colleagues around the country.

The deadline for hospitals to apply is Aug. 19. The fee is \$2,000 per hospital.
