CDC and public health officials in several states are investigating a multistate outbreak of *Salmonella* Stanley and *Salmonella* Pomona infections linked to small turtles.

### **Fungal Meningitis Outbreak Associated with Procedures Performed under Epidural Anesthesia in Matamoros, Mexico**

CDC, the Mexican Ministry of Health, and US state and local health departments are responding to a multinational outbreak of fungal meningitis among people who had procedures under epidural anesthesia in Matamoros, Mexico.

## **Salmonella Outbreak Linked to Backyard Poultry**

CDC and public health officials in several states are investigating multistate outbreaks of *Salmonella* infections (serotypes Braenderup, Enteritidis, Indiana, Infantis, Mbandaka, and Typhimurium) linked to contact with backyard poultry.

## **Hepatitis A Outbreak Linked to Frozen Organic Strawberries**

*As of September 4, 2023, this investigation is over.*

CDC, state public health and regulatory officials, and the FDA are investigating a multistate outbreak of hepatitis A linked to frozen organic strawberries.

## **Drug-resistant *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* Associated with Artificial Tears**

CDC is collaborating with the FDA and state and local health departments to investigate a multistate outbreak of an extensively drug-resistant strain of *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* linked to artificial tears.

## **Monkeypox (mpox) Virus Outbreak**

In the United States, cases of mpox (formerly monkeypox) have declined since peaking in August 2022, but **the outbreak is not over**. Pediatric cases are rare (<0.1% of all cases).
