The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) has announced the recall of the following products. Consumers should stop using recalled products unless otherwise instructed. Kids' bicycles



Pacific Cycle is recalling 147,000 Pacific Kids' Igniter and Pacific Bubble Pop 20-inch bicycles because the handlebar can come loose and riders can fall.

Helmets
