Supplemental Information

The following is a semistructured interview guide with suggested probing questions:

- 1. Tell me why you are here in the hospital.
 - a. What went through your head when it happened?
 - b. What do you think happened?
- 2. What concerned you the most that made you come to the hospital?
 - a. Did you think he needed to be admitted?
- 3. Thinking back to the conversations you had with the medical team, how did they explain to you what had happened?

- a. What did you think when they said that to you? What do you think of that explanation?
- b. How do you explain what happened?
- Tell me more about how conversations with the medical team have gone for you during this hospital stay.
 - a. Can you give an example of something you talked about?
- 5. Did you have an idea of what to expect when talking to the medical team?
 - a. Did you have an idea of what you wanted from the medical team when you first came?

- Tell me about what testing or monitoring has been done over the past day.
 - a. How do you feel? What do you think about what is been done in the hospital?
 - b. What is it like being in the hospital?
- 7. Has the team talked to you yet about a plan for going home?
 - a. How did that conversation go?
 - b. Do you feel ready to go home? What would make you feel ready?
- 8. What will it be like at home now? Will anything be different?
 - a. Can you give me an example?
