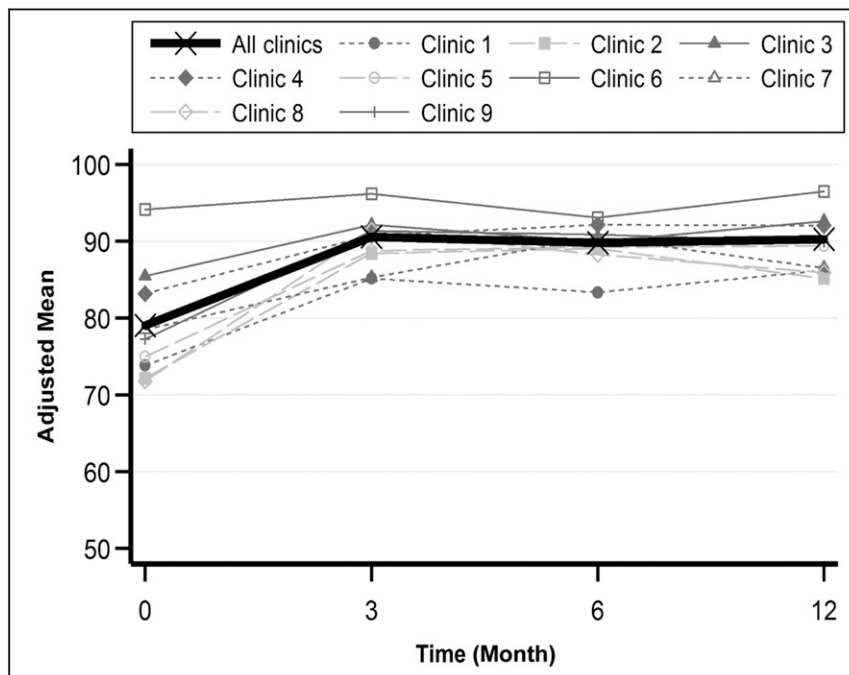
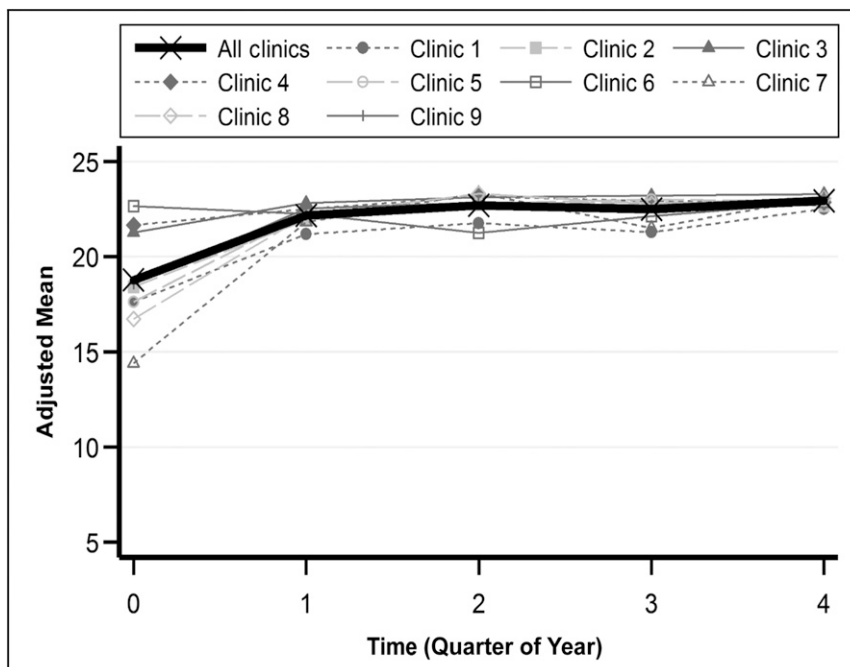

### SUPPLEMENTAL FIGURE 9

Adjusted mean QoL scores (overall and by clinics) at baseline and 3, 6, and 12 months. Adjusted mean QoL scores, by clinic and overall (all clinics), increasing from baselines (0 months) to months 3, 6, and 12, with the greatest increase seen by month 3. Thereafter, QoL scores remained higher through the end of the study. Clinic 6's mean score was already high at baseline and did not change over time, whereas other clinics improved by month 3 and stayed high through the end of the study. Y-axis units show only QoL scores between 50 and 100 (rather than 0–100) for easy reading.

Adjusted mean asthma control (overall and by clinics) at quarters baseline and quarters 1, 2, 3, and 4. Adjusted mean asthma control scores, by clinic and overall (all clinics), increasing from baseline to quarters 1, 2, 3, and 4, with the greatest increase occurring by quarter 1. Thereafter, asthma control scores remained higher through the end of the study. Mean scores for clinics 3 and 4 were high at baseline and had a slight but not significant increase over time. Clinic 6's mean score was high at baseline and did not change over time. The remaining clinics had baseline scores <19 (not well-controlled asthma) and improved to well-controlled asthma scores overtime. Y-axis units show only asthma control scores between 13 and 25 (rather than 5–25) for easy reading.
