- In this study, we find short-term, long-term, and cumulative associations between discrimination and mental health, substance use, and well-being for young adults in a longitudinal nationally representative sample.

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- This national, retrospective cohort study of children demonstrated that the current recommended childhood immunization schedule does not increase the risk of T1DM.
